Xuefei Yang is acclaimed as one of the world's finest classical guitarists. Born in Beijing, she became the first internationally recognised Chinese guitarist on the world stage. She is now based in the UK and her international success has led her to be invited to play in more than 50 countries at numerous prestigious venues, and is frequently invited to play with the world's leading orchestras. She is one of the few guitarists whose artistry connects with audiences far beyond the guitar fraternity.

Xuefei made the list of top 6 classical guitarists in BBC Music Magazine, and is one of three classical guitarists to make the top 50 women guitarists in Guitar Player magazine.

Trevor Pinnock is one of the pioneers of the modern revival of early music performance, founding The English Concert in 1972 and the European Brandenburg Ensemble in 2006. He appears as a guest conductor with many of the world's leading symphony orchestras as well as giving solo harpsichord and chamber music recitals worldwide.

In 1992 he was awarded the honour of CBE and he is also an Officer des Arts et des Lettres.

Jonathan Sage has given recitals throughout Europe and as a concerto soloist has appeared with several orchestras including the London Mozart Players and the Dartington Festival Orchestra. As an orchestral musician, he has performed with the London Mozart Players, New Mozart Orchestra and the British Philharmonic Concert Orchestra. Jonathan's debut CD, Counterpoint, has received critical acclaim.

The Keats Quartet perform in concerts and other events nationwide and have given recitals at the Norwich Chamber Music Festival, Peterborough Cathedral, Glastonbury Abbey and Wells Cathedral. They have also worked in collaboration with ensembles such as the Choir of Clare College, Cambridge, the Early Music Wells Consort, and new opera company, Black Robin Opera.

Dutch-Italian Cecilia Bernardini is widely considered to be one of the most versatile violinists of her generation, obtaining prizes in several major violin competitions. As a soloist, she has performed in many of Europe's prestigious concert halls.

Working in the UK, Europe, and North America as a soloist and chamber musician, Matthew Wadsworth has appeared at most major concert halls and festivals, and can often be heard on radio, both in live performance and recordings.
